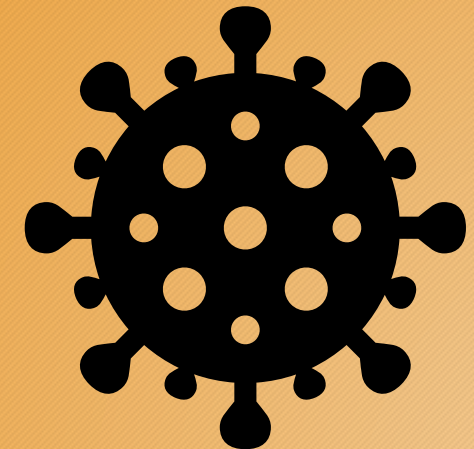
Health Protocols and updates



Event Statement

Ways we are working to keep you safe

- If your group is traveling together to Jubilation, we anticipate they can camp, eat, and sleep in same area. We will call this your **“trusted group”**
 - Your group may bring individual tents or group tents. This is up to you.
 - When alone with your **“trusted group”** masks are recommended but not required.
 - Mealtimes (eating)
 - Sleeping
 - Your group Camping Site area

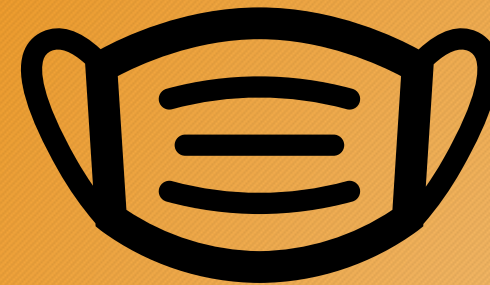




Ways we are working to keep you safe

- We will be outdoors for all program and will **require masks** when in close contact with other groups.

- Vehicles
- Bathrooms
- Nurses Station
- Office





Immunizations



- Immunizations are not required but recommended for both adults and girls.
- CampDoc will ask in your health profile:
This is only for our nursing staff for health profile evaluation.
 - Immunization status
 - Dates of immunization
 - Past test results





Pre-Event Evaluation

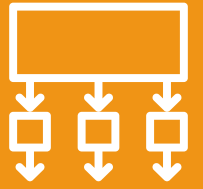
Prescreening Prior to Event



- CampDoc will ask you to complete a Prescreening 24-48 hours prior to Jubilation.
- If you have a possible exposure: You must follow the current CDC recommendation on Quarantine and Isolation based on your immunization status.

- If you are feeling sick prior to Jubilation, we ask you not attend.
- If you do not complete the prescreening, show up at the event, your group will not be admitted to Jubilation.
