FACILITATION OF MASQUERADE SESSION

Core Activity Est. 2 Hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Review Planning and Preparation resources under the J2J tab on the website - SWAPS, Group Flag and Sit-Upons and Masquerade Masks and decide.▪ Print off and practice a few songs or listen to CD's identified on the song resources.
Extra Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Do you know any other camp or traditional Girl Scout songs? Can you teach them?▪ Decide what "Dream Mask" you will bring to the Ball and make.
Advanced Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Have a group or girls who attended Jubilation or an event that they swapped at come to a meeting and show what was received.▪ Have a group of older girls facilitate making SWAPS, Sit upon, Masks and songs.▪ Make a group song book.▪ Make up a marching chant for your group.
