### GOAL

### FACILITATION OF CRYSTAL BALL SESSION

<b>Core Activity</b> Est. 15 min.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Review <a href="#">Respectful Behavior Agreement</a>.</li><li>▪ Discuss how and why these would be important at a large event.</li><li>▪ What can you do to ensure you follow this agreement?</li><li>▪ Discuss possible consequences to behavior issues.</li></ul>
<b>Extra Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Do you have a group behavior agreement?</li><li>▪ Create a group agreement to follow at troop/group meetings and outings.</li></ul>
<b>Advanced Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Create a skit or play to show behavior issues and resolutions.</li><li>▪ Create a What If? Scenario game based on behavior situations.</li></ul>

## Jubilation 2018 Respectful Behavior Agreement

*Jubilation event staff believes girls learn best through positive experiences and leaders and staff will guide girls in a way that helps them learn to cooperate with their peers and have a positive experience to enhance their growth, development and leadership skills.*

**Because my attitude and behavior are critical to the success of Jubilation;  
As a participant, I agree to the following:**

*I am representing the Girl Scout movement.  
I will uphold the Girl Scout Promise and Law.*

### The Girl Scout Promise

*On my honor, I will try:  
To serve God and my country,  
To help people at all times,  
And to live by the Girl Scout Law.*

### The Girl Scout Law

*I will do my best to be  
honest and fair,  
friendly and helpful,  
considerate and caring,  
courageous and strong, and  
responsible for what I say and do,  
and to  
respect myself and others,  
respect authority,  
use resources wisely,  
make the world a better place, and  
be a sister to every Girl Scout.*

### Personal Responsibility:

- I will be a positive role model.
- I will have a positive and cooperative attitude and will lead and follow by example.
- I am responsible for my belongings and will not hold event participants, Girl Scouts of Silver Sage, or Girl Scouts of the USA responsible for their loss or damage.
- I am responsible for any damage that occurs to an event facility as a result of my behavior. I will adhere to the fact that a Girl Scout always leaves a place cleaner than how she found it.
- I am responsible to be on time to program events and ceremonies.

### Respecting Myself and Others:

- I will be living and interacting with people who have values and cultures different from mine. I will respect those differences.
- Jubilation event staff, leaders and girls shall be treated with respect and will respect differences of opinion when they occur.

- If a problem arises, I use problem solving skills to find a win-win solution. If mediation is needed, please find a staff member to help you find a solution.
- I will treat program presenters with respect, and give my full attention, to all instructions and information so I know the expectations and safety rules of the program activity.

**Personal Safety Guidelines:**

- *Bullying, physical, emotional or mental abuse, alcohol use, illegal activities or disruptive activities to the event will not be tolerated.*
- I will use the Buddy System at **ALL** times.
- I will keep myself healthy by staying well-hydrated, eating a proper diet, getting enough rest, and dressing properly.
- I will wear Tennis shoes – except when event program states otherwise.
- The use of obscene language, alcohol, and illegal or unauthorized drugs will not be tolerated, and I understand that usage during the event will result in expulsion. Illegal or unauthorized drugs will be reported to authorities and legal action is mandatory.
- A smoking area will be provided away from the event for adults.

**Event Safety Guidelines:**

- Security personnel are available and they monitor the event area at night to ensure all participants are safe.
- Girl Scout must stay in the areas designated for Girl Scout use.
  - Grandstands are **NOT** for Girl Scout use.
  - Girls must stay out of parking area.
  - Leaders will have access to parking area and vehicles.
- If a leader needs to leave the fairgrounds for any reason, please check out with appropriate staff. Please make sure the girl/leader ratio is covered for your group during the absence.
- No vehicles in the camping area with exception of staff event vehicles. This is to ensure the safety of all participants.
- I will follow the instructions of the event staff for drop off, parking, and pickup of camping equipment.
- Camping areas are assigned by group. Please set up in your assigned area, if not you will be asked to move to your assigned area.
- Be prepared for any kind of weather. Take the extra step to assure everyone will be comfortable during the event.
- I will be aware and report and safety issues to staff immediately.

**Consequences:**

- **Failure to abide by this agreement can result in me or my group being sent home.**
- **If you are asked to leave for any reason, you must make arrangements and this may result in additional expense to you or your group.**

**This agreement provides limits that are clearly defined and will be monitored to provide a positive experience for all participants.**
